And talks the same.

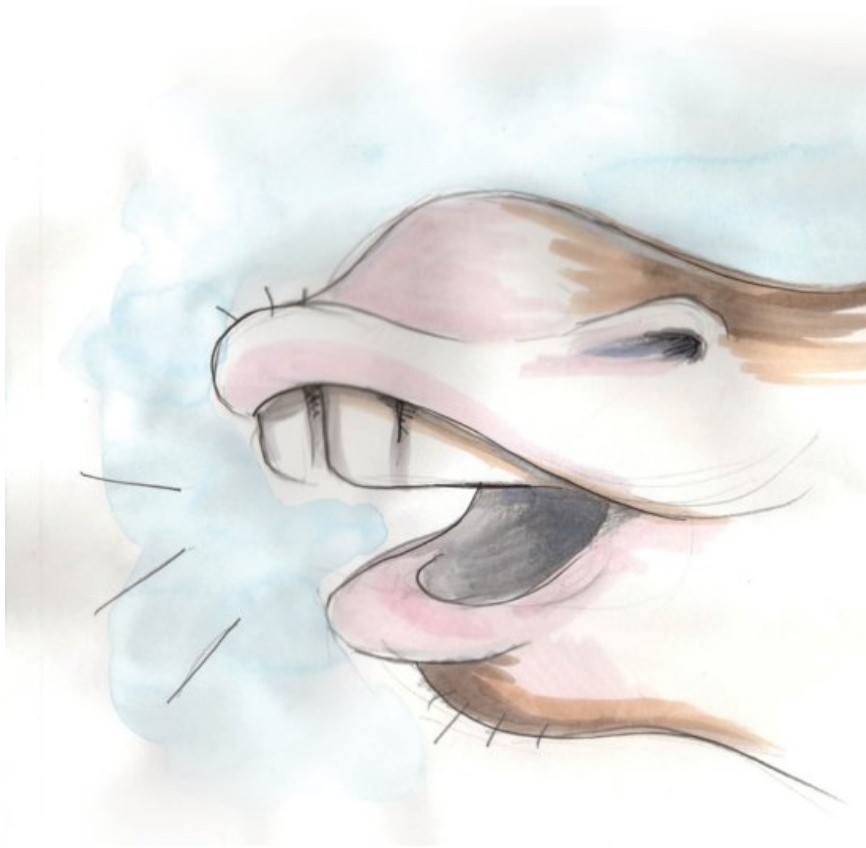




And even has my curls.

you!

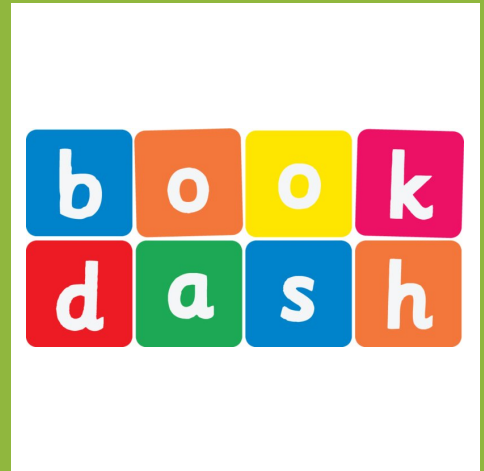
