I feel bad when my dad says he does not have money.





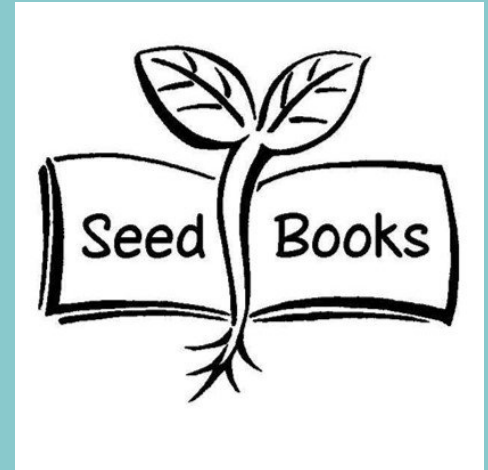
