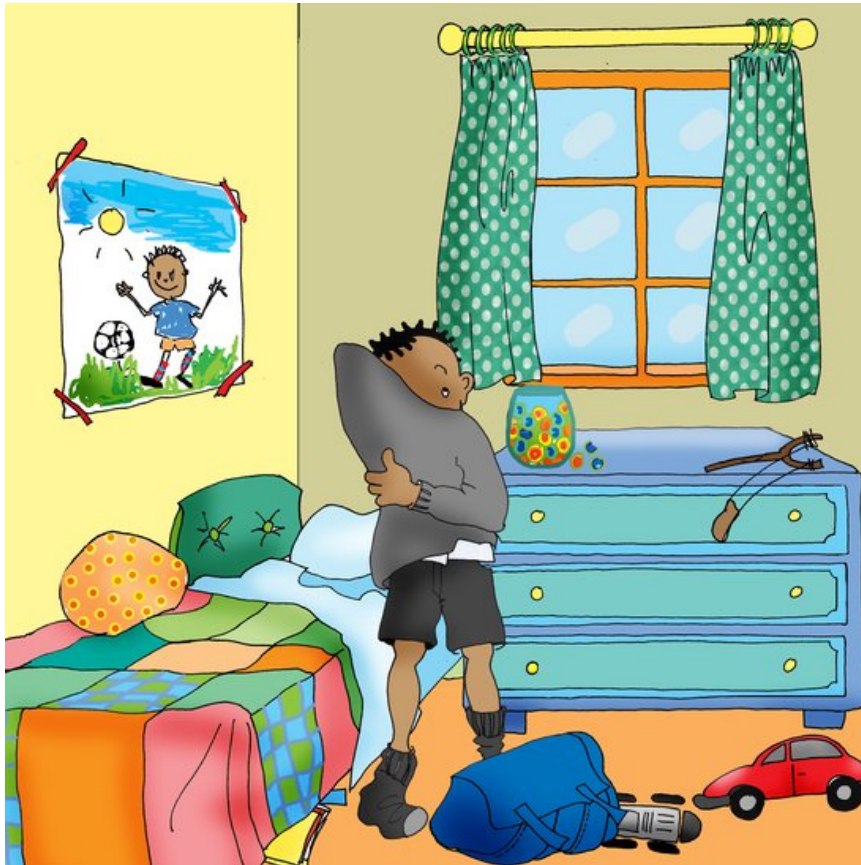


Porridge
